Pre-Dinner Activities

Before dinner, guests can take a ½ hour narrated tram ride through the grounds of the Arboretum and take a walk through the nearby Fragrance Garden.



Pre-dinner cocktails will be held in the original 1923 library wing of the Morton mansion complete with English oak paneling, carved stone mantelpiece, and decorative plaster ceiling. The room's south windows contain ten stained glass medallions depicting famous trees from history and legend. Visitors can also enjoy other photographs, letters, and Morton memorabilia displayed in the book cabinets.



Dinner

A sit-down dinner will be served in the Arbor Room, which offers spectacular views through floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking the Arboretum landscape. Guests can enjoy dinner inside and mingle outside on the stone terrace or at the nearby Four Seasons Garden.
